I focused on developing a minimal typographical approach, coupled with a refined art direction for photoshoots, and a revamp of the website. I also collaborated with several producers for both screen printing onto the bottle and new packaging.







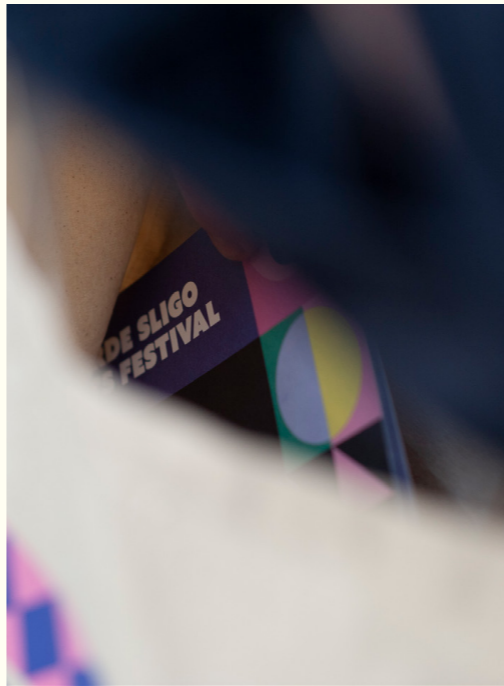
Cairde Sligo Arts Festival

As the largest arts festival in the North West of Ireland, Cairde has been a summer fixture in Sligo for many years, bringing a diverse range of artists and performers from around the world to the town.

In 2022, I worked on a rebrand of the festival identity, built around the idea of the “*carnival coming to town.*” The concept embraced a punchy, playful visual language, capturing the energy, spectacle, and sense of wonder associated with a funfair, designed to appeal to audiences of all ages.

Using a vibrant colour palette and a bold graphic set, the refreshed brand identity aimed to bring a sense of whimsy and excitement to life across multiple applications, including posters, social media, flags, and signage around the town.

The Pepper Pot Cafe

The Pepperpot Café is an artisanal café and bakery located in Dublin's Powerscourt Centre, operating for over 15 years.

In 2018, I developed a flexible branding system designed to unify the café's messaging across a wide range of applications.

Using a simple yet effective border device and a minimal colour palette, the designs worked together to create a consistent brand voice across all applications.

In the years since, I have worked closely with the client to develop the brand and adapt to changing business conditions in the wake of the pandemic, creating everything from signage and packaging to menus and digital applications.





Guzzle 1 & 2

Guzzle is an independent food, art, and drink publication, founded in Dublin and now based in London. I worked on the initial branding and website, as well as the first and second issues.

The task at first was creating a punchy but thoughtful aesthetic that best reflected the diverse array of essays, poems and photography projects that featured in the magazine.

Along with a range of illustrators and artists, helping to bring the contributions to life, I used a strong typographical focus and a clear structure to develop a robust but adaptive approach to help cement the tone across two issues.



PI


In 2019, I worked on the initial branding for a new wood-fired pizza restaurant that would go on to win multiple awards and firmly establish itself as a Dublin institution.

The core message behind the brand was for “*Delicious pizza. Great hospitality. Beautiful spaces. Enhance. Repeat.*”, with the idea of constantly getting better being central to their brand goals.

Coupled with the concept of the π symbol and wordplay around “pie,” we developed a minimal, typographically led approach. Over the years I developed a close working relationship with the client, and worked on a wide array of applications, from signage, to printed menus, and their website.

•OUR PIZZA•

Our journey started not in Naples, Italy but here in Ireland - Abbeylisk, County Laois. Rog White, Co-Owner and Head Chef, built a pizza oven with his own hands in his parents' back garden after catching the pizza bug at Ballymaloe Cookery School in County Cork. He followed that with stints at two of San Francisco's best pizza restaurants. That journey, plus lots and lots of trial and error, tweaking, refining, false starts, early mornings, late nights, an unwavering passion and a quest for perfection is the story behind every PI pizza.

DOUGH
Our pizza is what we call 'slow fast food'. We start by making dough fresh on site every day using the world's best pizza flour - Caputo Blue '00', from Naples. The fineness of the flour coupled with its low gluten content is the perfect starting point. What follows is a 72 hour process, with minimal yeast, that yields an incredibly digestible and flavourful dough that you feel good after eating.

TOMATOES
12 Tomatoes from 10 producers put through their paces over months of taste tests. 1 winner - sweet plump flesh, low acidity and great tomato taste.

TOPPINGS
We use the best of what we've tasted (and we tasted a lot to find the best). We are proud to include artisan Irish suppliers such as Toons Bridge Dairy (mozzarella, Fior di latte) and Gubbeen Smokehouse (chorizo).

CRUST
Leoparding (leopard spots) is the term for the charred blisters on the crust of our pizzas which capture that amazing wood fire taste. Our generous crust is crispy on the outside and chewy on the inside - to be devoured, not discarded.

I worked on the overall design, tone, and layout of the document, drawing on the shopfronts themselves for inspiration for the typographic and colour choices.



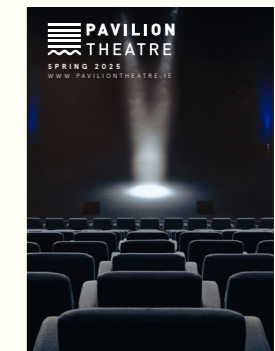




Pavillion Theatre
